Police Investigating Fatal Pedestrian Crash

Hingham, MA – Police are investigating a crash in which a pedestrian died after being struck by a truck Monday on George Washington Boulevard in front of the Hingham District Courthouse.

The crash occurred Monday, December 5, 2016 at approximately 11:14am in front of 28 George Washington Blvd. A preliminary investigation indicates the pedestrian was struck in the road by a 2016 Ford F350 that was traveling north on George Washington Blvd. The driver of the truck, a 23 year old Hingham man, remained at the scene and was later transported by ambulance to South Shore Hospital.

The pedestrian, a 56 year old Bridgewater woman, was transported by ambulance to South Shore Hospital where she died. George Washington Boulevard remained closed until 2:35pm while Hingham Police and State Troopers from the Massachusetts State Police Collision and Reconstruction Section (CARS) investigated the scene.

At this time, no citations or charges have been filed against the driver. The crash remains under investigation by the Hingham Police and the State Police Detectives assigned to the Plymouth County District Attorney's Office. The names of the driver and pedestrian are not being released at this time.
