Police Response After Threat to School

Hingham, MA – Officers responded to the South Shore Educational Collaborative School Thursday in response to a report of a threat made by a former student. The report came from the School Resource Officer in the school. While Officers were at the school, that former student was located attending another school out of the area.

On Thursday, January 31, 2019 at 1:50pm several Police Officers were dispatched to the South Shore Educational Collaborative School at 75 Abington Street for a report of a threat made to the school that may involve a weapon. The threat was made by a former student. This occurred near dismissal time. Students remained inside the school.

At 2:42pm, Officers were able to confirm that the former student was not actually in the area. He was located at a school that he was attending in another town. This incident remains under investigation. No charges have been filed at this time.

The School Resource Officer assigned to this school is one of five full-time School Resource Officers in the Hingham Police Department.
