

COYOTE/WILDLIFE YARD CHECK LIST

These are some of the food sources or scents coyotes seek out to find easy fast food in our yards, instead of going deeper into the woods to hunt for the food they should be. If you have any of the items in your yard, we are not saying you cannot have them, but please, secure, clean up after daily or remove to a safe location or inside. Working to secure these issues, will not only help your own yard, your safety, but your neighbors too from coyote visits and sightings.



- Chickens
- Waterfowl (domestic ducks, geese, domestic turkeys, guinea hens, etc.)
- Rabbit Hutches, pets living outside, or baby farm animals that aren't able to protect themselves
- Compost Piles (All wildlife life will eat, including coyotes, fruits and veggies)
- Bird feeders
- Drip pans on Grills
- Scraps from Grills
- Food left in or around a fire pit cooked or uncooked
- Food left out overnight or during the day unattended from a barbeque or outside event
- Dog or cat waste/Urine scent built up in an area
- Dogs or Cats being feed outside/ bones that dogs chew on
- Trash/Trash cans/ Dumpsters/food wrappers with food residue or half eaten food left inside the wrapper or container on the ground
