## **ORDER OF THE HARBORMASTER**

**PURSUANT to M.G.L. CHAPTER 102, the HINGHAM HARBORMASTER, has ORDERED:**

1. All boats removed from the Town Pier before September 22, 2019; and
2. All boats, moorings, or other objects removed from the Inner Harbor Mooring Basin before October 1, 2019.

The **TOWN OF HINGHAM** is preparing for its maintenance dredging of the **Inner Harbor Mooring Basin** conducted every ten years. The **INNER HARBOR MOORING BASIN MUST** be clear of all **BOATS, MOORINGS, or OTHER OBJECTS** to allow for dredging related activities.

The **HARBORMASTER** MAY REMOVE BOATS REMAINING in the **INNER HARBOR MOORING BASIN ON or AFTER OCTOBER, 1 2019**. Pursuant to M.G.L. CH. 102 § 24 which states,

**"A harbor master may, at the expense of the master or owners thereof, cause the removal of any vessel which lies in his harbor and is not moved when directed by him, and upon the neglect or refusal of such master or owners on demand to pay such expense, he may recover the same from them in contract, to the use of the town where the harbor is situated."**

**Boats will be welcomed back next spring at the direction of the **HARBORMASTER**.**
